Focus Skill: Persistence




What is Tinkergarten?


The Tinkergarten Learning Journey



	 Lesson 2 Frozen Friends	<p>In honor of our most persistent frigid friend, the Ice Worm, we will explore frozen treats. We'll test different tools and strategies to free pretend worms from their frozen homes and excavate for objects locked inside of frozen treasures.</p>
	 Lesson 3 Hibernation Station	<p>Groundhogs play a special role in a tradition tied to the arrival of Spring, but they also have a hibernation superpower to survive the winter. In this lesson we'll build cozy dens for pretend slumbering friends.</p>
	 Lesson 4 Woodpecker's Work	<p>This time, we get to play like woodpeckers, using tools to peck our way into various materials and the winter world around us. Like the work of our persistent friend the woodpecker, this lesson is all about the importance and power of repetition.</p>
